DID YOU KNOW?

- Breast cancer is the **MOST COMMON** cancer in women!
- Often, cervical cancer shows **NO** noticeable signs or symptoms!
- Detected early, breast and cervical cancers **CAN BE** successfully treated!



Routine mammograms, breast exams, and pap tests can detect cancer early and provide women with better treatment options and results!

WHO IS ELIGIBLE FOR THIS PROGRAM?

There are no income guidelines for this program. You may be eligible for services through this program if:

- You are a women:
- You live in Knox, Warren, or Henderson County;
- You are between the ages of 35 to 64 years;
- You have no Medicaid or Medicare Part B coverage;
- You have no health insurance; OR
- Your health insurance will not cover these services.

WHAT SERVICES DOES THE PROGRAM OFFER?

The Illinois Breast and Cervical Cancer Program provides **FREE** mammograms, clinical breast exams, and Pap tests to women who qualify.

EVEN IF YOU HAVE ALREADY BEEN DIAGNOSED WITH CANCER YOU MAY RECEIVE FREE TREATMENT IF YOU QUALIFY...

Now, more women than ever before can take advantage of the free screenings & treatment...

EVEN women who have been diagnosed by a medical provider and found to have breast or cervical cancer may qualify to participate in the IBCCP Program through the Breast and Cervical Cancer Prevention Treatment Act.
